

Changes to Revitalisation of Shops (ROS) Scheme

Funding	Current scheme	Enhanced Scheme
For upgrading of common areas*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Budget of \$20,000 per shop ● Shop owner pays half ● HDB and town council pay other half, up to \$10,000 per sold shop 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Budget of \$35,000 per shop ● Shop owner pays 20 per cent, capped at \$5,000 ● HDB and town council pay 80 per cent, up to \$30,000 per sold shop
For engagement of consultants	-	New funding of up to \$10,000 for merchants' association to engage consultants for ROS upgrading
For formation of merchants' associations	-	New start-up fund of \$10,000 to encourage shops in town and neighbourhood centres without merchants' association to form one among themselves

NOTE: *HDB and town council will continue to foot the entire upgrading cost for rental shops.
