

# Rejuvenating Pasir Ris

The coastal town of Pasir Ris will be made over within the next decade. Residents can expect a town centre with more shops, a partly-sheltered community space, and about 2,000 new HDB units.

A new 1.2km elevated “highway” for pedestrians and cyclists will connect the town centre to nearby Pasir Ris Park.

## ← PASIR RIS, GO →

An elevated “highway” to Pasir Ris Park will make going car-lite even more of a breeze. The Central Greenway will take visitors from the town centre to the park in just five minutes by bike, or 10 minutes on foot. This will help pedestrians and cyclists avoid having to wait at traffic lights.



## NATURE LIVING

An iconic feature of the town is Pasir Ris Park, which will also undergo a facelift. Visitors to the park will get new sand play areas, a thematic playground, and even a maze. About 2,000 new HDB units will be built near the park, offering views of Sungei Api Api, a river that flows through the town.



## COMMUNITY SPACES



Four neighbourhood centres and seven neighbourhood parks will be upgraded to offer residents a chance to mingle and interact. Linking them will be a 5km community mall, which will serve as a walking and cycling spine to help residents go car-lite.

## REFRESHED TOWN CENTRE

In about five to 10 years, Pasir Ris Town Centre, located next to Pasir Ris MRT station, will boast new shops, residential units and a partly-sheltered community space for events. An upgraded bus interchange will also be integrated into the new mixed-use development, which will have a dedicated pick-up and drop-off point for full-time national servicemen undergoing military training on Pulau Tekong.
