

Johor Baru–Singapore Rapid Transit System (RTS)

Singapore and Malaysia yesterday agreed to work towards signing a bilateral agreement on the RTS Link by December this year. The train service will start by Dec 31, 2024.

- **There will be two stations:**

- Woodlands North station on the Thomson-East Coast Line
- Bukit Chagar station in Johor Baru, close to JB Sentral train station

- **The 4km track will cross the Johor Strait on a 25m-high bridge.**

- **It can carry up to 10,000 passengers in each direction, per hour.**

- **Customs and immigration facilities for both countries will be co-located at both stations.**

- This means commuters leaving Singapore clear immigration checks for both countries at Woodlands North station.
- Commuters leaving Malaysia clear immigration checks for both countries at Bukit Chagar station
