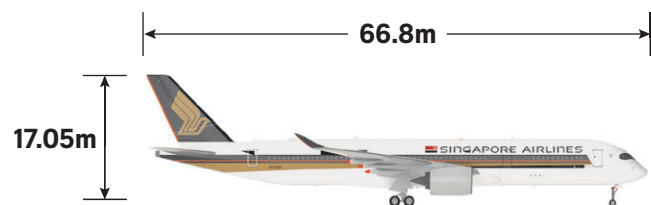
About 16,700 km or just under 19 hours' flight time. The distance from the North to South Pole is just over 40,000km.

The longest non-stop flight today is Qatar Airways' Auckland-Doha route – about 17½ hours.

The A350-900ULR (Ultra Long Range)

- The latest variant of the A350 family can fly farther than any other commercial aircraft.
- Singapore Airlines has ordered seven of the planes, which it will use on non-stop flights between Singapore and the US, including the world's longest commercial service between Singapore and Newark.



The A350-900ULR can fly up to about 18,000km or over 20 hours of non-stop flying time

With modifications to the fuel system, it can carry an extra 24,000 litres of fuel – up to 165,000 litres

Maximum take-off weight of 280 tonnes

Carbon fibre fuselage and wings

Extended winglets are among aerodynamic enhancements that allow the plane to fly farther

Three Singapore-Newark routes
