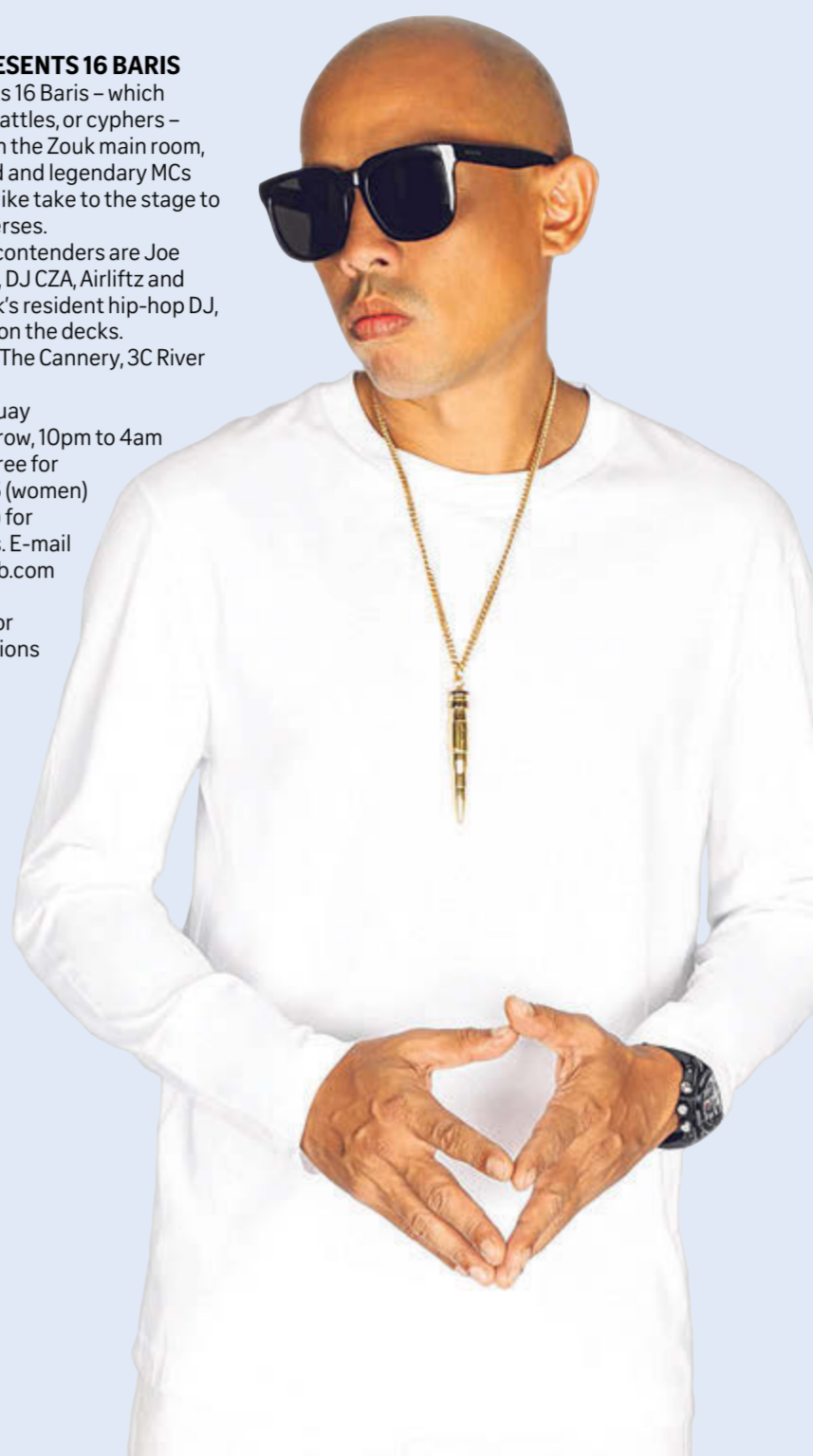
**CE LA VI PRESENTS CLAPTONE**
