

# Singapore on orange alert

The Disease Outbreak Response System Condition (Dorscon) status has been raised from yellow to orange. Here are some new measures announced yesterday.

## LARGE-SCALE EVENTS:

- Event organisers should cancel or defer events, or take precautions, including temperature screenings.

## WORKPLACES:

- Employers should conduct temperature-taking at least twice a day. Anyone who is unwell should see a doctor.

## BUSINESS CONTINUITY:

- Employers to step up preparations for business continuity. Employees can work from home, or in separate teams.

## HEALTHCARE INSTITUTIONS:

- Patients with pneumonia will be cared for separately from other patients to reduce risk of transmission.

## SCHOOLS:

- All inter-school and external activities like camps will be suspended until the end of the March holidays.
