

# How to get a digital pre-departure Covid-19 test certificate

The digitalisation effort is aimed at eliminating paper-based health documents, including negative Covid-19 test results and proof of vaccination, which can be easily misplaced or altered.

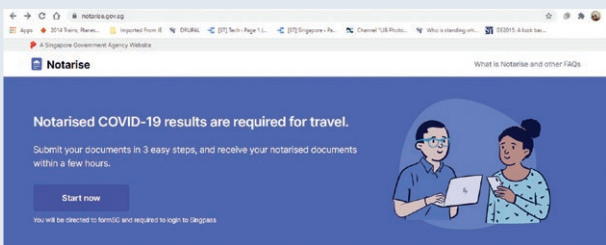
**1** Book a pre-departure Covid-19 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test at a Ministry of Health-approved clinic.

**2** Go for PCR testing at the clinic. Sample is sent to a laboratory.

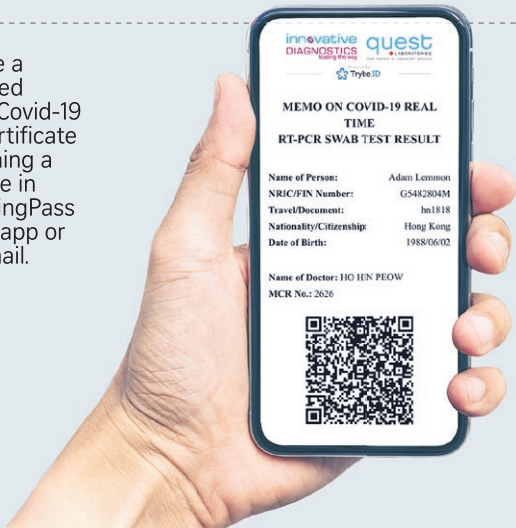


**3** Receive a digital Covid-19 test certificate via e-mail from the clinic or the laboratory.

**4** Notarise – or have the Ministry of Health certify – the digital Covid-19 test certificate by logging in to the Government's Notarise website (<http://www.notarise.gov.sg>) using one's SingPass credentials, and uploading the certificate.



**5** Receive a notarised digital Covid-19 test certificate containing a QR code in one's SingPass Mobile app or via e-mail.



**6** Airline and immigration officials can scan the QR code to check the authenticity of the certificate. This is done using a tool called Verify, developed by the public sector's technology agency GovTech. Singapore Airlines is trialling another tool developed by Temasek-linked firm Affinidi to scan the QR code.
