
# Increasing capacity at social and business events

More people will be allowed at weddings and live performances from April 24, provided they are tested for Covid-19 before attending. Toh Ting Wei highlights the key changes.



## MARRIAGE SOLEMNISATIONS

Up to

people, in zones of up to 50 attendees each, with pre-event testing; or 100 without.

- Number includes wedding couple, but not the licensed solemniser and
- Bride and groom must take pre-event tests for solemnisation-only events involving more than 100 attendees.



### WEDDING RECEPTIONS

people, in zones of up to 50 attendees each, with pre-event testing; or 100 without.

- Number includes the wedding couple, but not the vendors.
- Everyone, including the bride and groom, must take pre-event tests if more than 100 people attend.



## **LIVE PERFORMANCES**

people with pre-event testing, or 250 without.

## **PILOT BUSINESS-TO-BUSINESS EVENTS**

people with pre-event testing, or 250 without.



#### **PILOT SPECTATOR SPORTS EVENTS**

seated spectators with pre-event testing, or 250 without.



## **WAKES AND FUNERALS**

can attend on the day of burial/cremation, from 30 now. The cap for other days remains unchanged. Pre-event testing is not required.
