

# Increasing capacity at social and business events

More people will be allowed at weddings and live performances from April 24, provided they are tested for Covid-19 before attending. **Toh Ting Wei** highlights the key changes.



## MARRIAGE SOLEMNISATIONS

Up to

# 250

people, in zones of up to 50 attendees each, with pre-event testing; or 100 without.

- Number includes wedding couple, but not the licensed solemniser and vendors.
- Bride and groom must take pre-event tests for solemnisation-only events involving more than 100 attendees.

## WEDDING RECEPTIONS

Up to

# 250

people, in zones of up to 50 attendees each, with pre-event testing; or 100 without.

- Number includes the wedding couple, but not the vendors.
- Everyone, including the bride and groom, must take pre-event tests if more than 100 people attend.

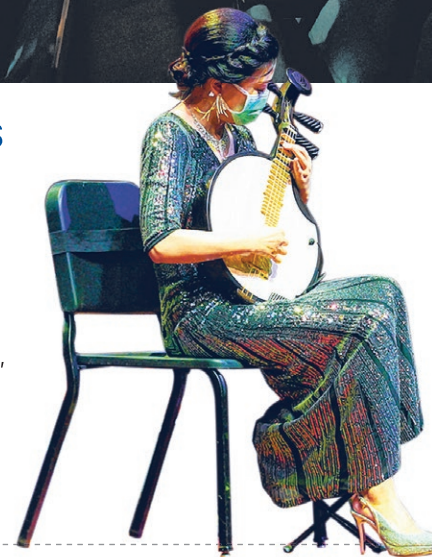


## LIVE PERFORMANCES

Up to

# 750

people with pre-event testing, or 250 without.



## PILOT BUSINESS-TO-BUSINESS EVENTS

# 750

people with pre-event testing, or 250 without.



## PILOT SPECTATOR SPORTS EVENTS

Up to

# 750

seated spectators with pre-event testing, or 250 without.



## WAKES AND FUNERALS

Up to

# 50

can attend on the day of burial/cremation, from 30 now. The cap for other days remains unchanged. Pre-event testing is not required.
