
Self-radicalised individuals issued with ISA* orders since 2015



 Restriction order: A person issued this order must abide by several conditions and restrictions. For example, he may not change

his address or job, or travel out of Singapore without approval and has to undergo rehabilitation to steer him away from radical ideology.

Order of detention: This means the individual is placed under arrest.
