10 NEW CASES OF LOCALLY TRANSMITTED COVID-19 INFECTION

As of 13 June 2021, 12pm, the Ministry of Health (MOH) has confirmed and verified that there are 10 new cases of locally transmitted COVID-19 infection. 8 are linked to previous cases, amongst whom 5 have already been placed on quarantine, and 3 were detected through surveillance. The remaining 2 cases are currently unlinked. The cases are in the community, and there are no new cases in the dormitories. There are 3 imported cases, who have already been placed on Stay-Home Notice (SHN) upon arrival in Singapore. Amongst the new cases today, 7 are asymptomatic, and were detected from our proactive screening and surveillance, while 6 were symptomatic.

2. Overall, the number of new cases in the community has decreased from 116 cases in the week before to 36 cases in the past week. The number of unlinked cases in the community has also decreased from 17 cases in the week before to 15 cases in the past week. We will continue to closely monitor these numbers, as well as the cases detected through our surveillance programme.

3. Amongst the 80 confirmed cases reported from 7 June to 13 June, 44 cases have tested positive for their serology tests, 27 have tested negative, and 9 serology test results are pending.

Case Details

a) Cases in the community: 10

There are 10 cases in the community today, of whom 8 are linked to previous cases and 2 are currently unlinked.

Currently unlinked cases

Detected through surveillance:

Case 64192 is a 23 year-old male India national who works as a nursing aide at All Saints Home (Hougang). He is asymptomatic, and was detected when he was tested for COVID-19 on 11 June as part of the nursing home's surveillance testing for staff. His pooled test result came back positive for COVID-19 on 11 June, and an individual test was done on the same day. His individual test result came back negative for COVID-19 on 11 June but another test administered on 12 June came back positive for COVID-19 infection. His Ct value was very high, which is indicative of a low viral load, and his serology test result is positive. He is likely to be shedding minute fragments of the virus RNA from a past infection, which are no longer transmissible and infective to others, but we have taken all necessary public health actions. Case 64192 received his first dose of COVID-19 vaccine on 10 March, and the second dose on 31 March.

Case 64184 is a 27 year-old male India national who works as an engineer at Ecoxplore Pte Ltd. He was tested for COVID-19 on 10 June as part of Rostered Routine Testing (RRT). He subsequently developed a fever on the same day. His pooled test result came back positive for COVID-19 on 11 June, and an individual test was administered. His individual test result came back positive for COVID-19 infection on 12 June. His serology test result is negative.

115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre cluster

Already quarantined:

Case 64187 is a 50 year-old male Bangladesh national who is employed by Theng Liang Lee Services as a conservancy worker at 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre. As he had been identified as a close contact of Case 64132¹, he was placed on quarantine on 11 June. He is asymptomatic, and was detected when he was tested for COVID-19 on 11 June during quarantine. His test result came back positive for COVID-19 infection on 12 June. His serology test result is pending.

Case 64193 is a 72 year-old male Singaporean who works at a sundry shop at 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre. As he had been identified as a close contact of Case 64132, he was placed on quarantine on 11 June. He was tested for COVID-19 on 12 June during quarantine, and his test result came back positive for COVID-19 infection on the same day. He subsequently developed a runny nose on 13 June. His

serology test result is pending. Case 64193 received his first dose of COVID-19 vaccine on 16 May, and the second dose on 6 June.

Case 64195 is a 67 year-old female Singaporean who is a food stall vendor at 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre. As she had been identified as a close contact of Case 64132, she was placed on quarantine on 12 June. She is asymptomatic, and was detected when she was tested for COVID-19 on 12 June during quarantine. Her test result came back positive for COVID-19 infection on 13 June. Her serology test result is pending. Case 64195 received her first dose of COVID-19 vaccine on 10 May, and the second dose on 31 May.

Case 64196 is a 65 year-old male Singaporean who is a food stall vendor at 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre. As he had been identified as a close contact of Case 64132, he was placed on quarantine on 11 June. He is asymptomatic, and was detected when he was tested for COVID-19 infection on 12 June during quarantine. His test result came back positive for COVID-19 infection the next day. His serology test result is pending. Case 64196 received his first dose of COVID-19 vaccine on 22 March, and the second dose on 12 April.

Case 64184 cluster

Detected through surveillance:

Case 64186 is a 19 year-old female Singaporean who works as a warehouse assistant at DHL Express (Singapore) Pte Ltd. She is a family member and household contact of Case 64191 and a household contact of Case 64184. She developed a fever, sore throat, cough and runny nose on 10 June and sought medical treatment at a polyclinic on 11 June, where she was administered both an antigen rapid test (ART) and polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test. She was immediately isolated when her ART result came back positive. Her PCR test result also came back positive for COVID-19 infection on the same day. Her serology test result is negative.

Case 64191 is a 39 year-old female Singaporean who is employed by Cleen First Services Pte Ltd as a cleaner at Emerald Park condominium. She is a family member and household contact of Case 64186 and a household contact of Case 64184. She developed a fever on 11 June and sought medical treatment at a polyclinic on 12 June, where she was administered both an ART and PCR test. She was immediately isolated when her ART result came back positive for COVID-19. Her PCR test also came back positive for COVID-19 infection on the same day. Her serology test result is negative.

Other linked cases

Already quarantined:

Case 64194 is a 59 year-old female Singaporean who works as a part-time cleaner at Crystal Lodge. She is a close contact of Case 64135², and was placed on quarantine

on 11 June. She is asymptomatic, and was detected when she was tested for COVID-19 on 12 June during quarantine. Her test result came back positive for COVID-19 infection on 13 June. Her serology test result is pending.

Detected through surveillance:

Case 64185 is a 66 year-old male Singaporean who is a retiree, and a family member of Case 64183³. He developed a cough on 11 June and sought medical treatment at a General Practitioner (GP) clinic on the same day, where he underwent both an ART and PCR test. His ART result was negative for COVID-19, but his PCR test result came back positive for COVID-19 infection on 12 June. His serology test result is pending.

b) Cases residing in dormitories: 0

There are no cases residing in dormitories today.

c) Imported cases: 3

Amongst the 3 imported cases,

- 2 (Cases 64188 and 64190) are Singapore Permanent Residents who returned from India.
- 1 (Case 64189) is a Work Permit holder who arrived from Indonesia and is a foreign domestic worker.

They have all already been placed on SHN upon arrival in Singapore and were tested while serving SHN.

5. Epidemiological investigations are in progress. In the meantime, all the identified close contacts of the cases have been isolated and placed on quarantine, and will be tested at the start and end of their quarantine period so that we can detect asymptomatic cases. We will also conduct serological tests for the close contacts to determine if the cases could have been infected by them.

Community surveillance testing for visitors to shops at 115 and 116 Bukit Merah View

6. MOH is investigating 6 cases (Cases 64132, 64158, 64187, 64193, 64195 and 64196) of COVID-19 infection amongst individuals who work in 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre. Our epidemiological investigations have found that there is likely ongoing transmission among individuals who work at the location. All staff and tenants who have been working at 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre from 25 May have been placed on quarantine, and will be tested during quarantine. In order to disrupt any wider, undetected community transmission, we will conduct special

testing operations for all staff and tenants who have been working in 116 Bukit Merah View from 25 May. We will also extend free COVID-19 testing to members of the public who had visited the shops at 115 and 116 Bukit Merah View between 25 May and 12 June. Please refer to <http://go.gov.sg/bmv-testing> for details on the testing operations.

7. All visitors to 115 and 116 Bukit Merah View between 25 May and 12 June are advised to monitor their health closely, and minimise social interactions as far as possible, for 14 days from their date of visit. They are encouraged to see a doctor immediately if they feel unwell.

8. To break any potential chain of transmission and enable deep cleaning of the premises, 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre has been closed to all members of the public from 13 June to 15 June 2021.

Update on condition of confirmed cases

9. 31 more cases of COVID-19 infection have been discharged from hospitals or community isolation facilities. In all, 61,869 have fully recovered from the infection and have been discharged from hospitals or community care facilities.

10. There are currently 130 confirmed cases who are still in hospital. Of these, most are stable or improving, and 1 is in critical condition in the intensive care unit. 243 are isolated and cared for at community facilities. These are those who have mild symptoms, or are clinically well but still test positive for COVID-19. 34 have passed away from complications due to COVID-19 infection.

Figure 1: Number of Community Unlinked and Linked Cases⁴

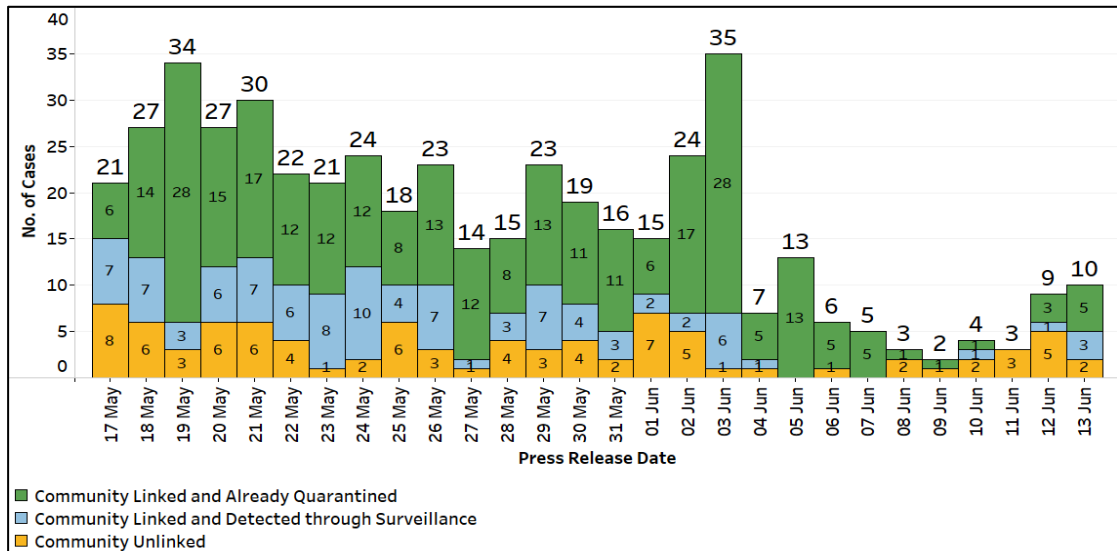
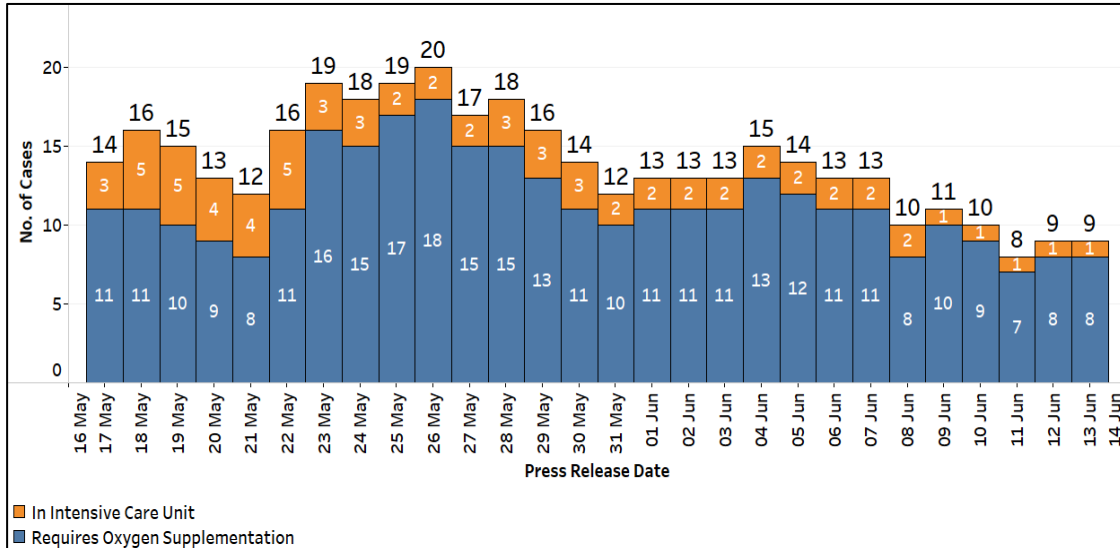
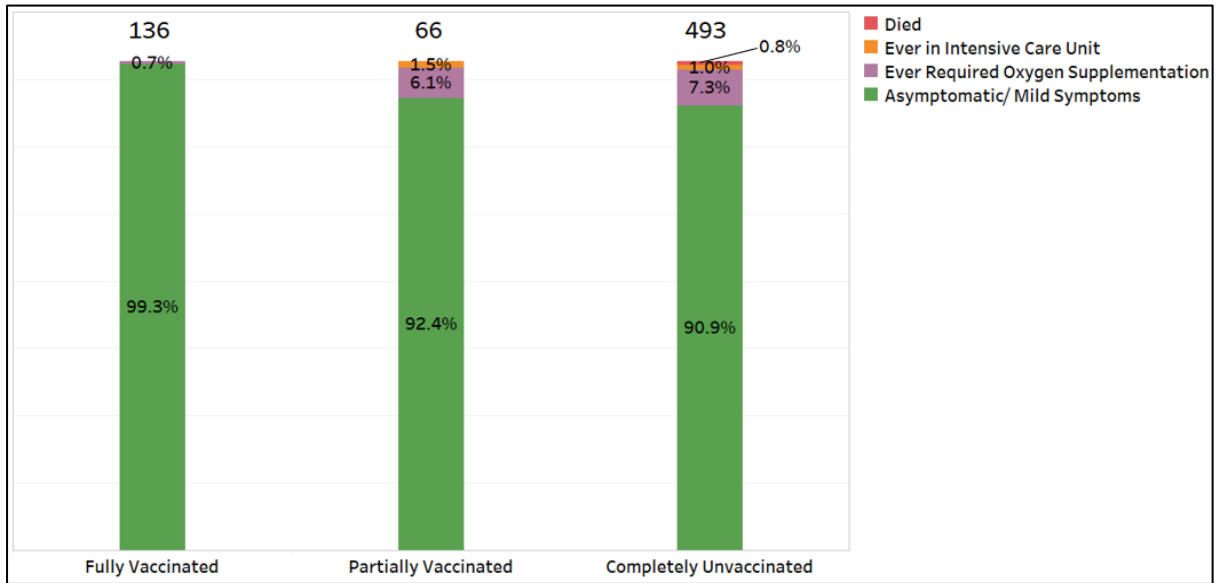


Figure 2: Number of Active Cases in Intensive Care Unit or Requiring Oxygen Supplementation

Open Clusters

Epidemiological investigations and contact tracing have uncovered links between cases.

- i. 6 of the confirmed cases (Cases 64132, 64158, 64187, 64193, 64195 and 64196) are linked to the 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre cluster with the most recent cases (Cases 64187 and 64193) linked to the cluster on 12 June, and Cases 64195 and 64196 linked to the cluster on 13 June. Case 64132 is a 74 year-old male Singaporean who works at a sundry store at 115 Bukit Merah View Market & Food Centre. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 9 June.
- ii. 3 of the confirmed cases (Cases 64184, 64186 and 64191) are linked to the Case 64184 cluster with the most recent cases (Case 64186) linked to the cluster on 11 June, and Cases 64184 and 64191 linked to the cluster on 12 June. Case 64184 is a 27 year-old male India national who works as an engineer at Ecoxplore Pte Ltd. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 12 June.
- iii. 4 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63290, 63383, 63384 and 63430) are linked to the Case 63290 cluster, with the most recent case (Case 63430) linked to the cluster on 18 May. Case 63290 is a 64 year-old female Singapore Permanent Resident who is currently unemployed. She was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 15 May.
- iv. 8 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63335, 63354, 63460, 63523, 63579, 63758, 63759 and 63762) are linked to the Pacific Law Corporation cluster with the most recent cases (Cases 63758, 63759 and 63762) linked to the cluster on 26 May. Case 63335 is a 57 year-old female Singaporean who works as an administrative personnel at Pacific Law Corporation. She was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 16 May.
- v. 3 of the confirmed cases (Cases 64149, 64180 and 64181) are linked to the MARINA ARIEL cluster, with the most recent cases (Cases 64180 and 64181) linked to the cluster on 12 June. Case 64149 is a 38 year-old male Indonesia national who is employed by Marina Offshore Pte Ltd as a sea crew on board tugboat MARINA ARIEL. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 11 June.
- vi. 4 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63399, 63900, 63917 and 64182) are linked to the Case 63399 cluster with the most recent case (Case 64182) linked to the cluster on 12 June. Case 63399 is a 35 year-old male Malaysia national who is a kitchen crew at Kota Zheng Zong Bak Kut Teh (Serangoon Gardens). He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 17 May.
- vii. 16 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63160, 63253, 63294, 63300, 63426, 63427, 63428, 63491, 63522, 63526, 63680, 63731, 63751, 63826, 63943 and 64120) are linked to the Changi Prison Complex cluster, with the most recent case (Case 64120) linked to the cluster on 9 June. Case 63160 is a 39 year-old male China national who is employed by SATS Food Services Pte Ltd as a chef at Changi Prison Complex. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 13 May.
- viii. 13 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63853, 63854, 63874, 63883, 63884, 63885, 63886, 63896, 63903, 63958, 64009, 64076 and 64117) are linked to the NTUC Foodfare (308 Anchorvale Road) cluster with the most recent case (Case 64117) linked to the cluster on 8 June. Case 63853 is a 33 year-old male Malaysia national who works as a kitchen assistant at Hua Zai Eating House Pte Ltd. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 29 May.

- ix. 33 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63924, 63949, 63950, 63961, 63962, 63974, 63976, 63977, 63979, 63980, 63982, 63983, 63984, 63985, 63986, 63987, 63988, 63989, 63990, 63991, 63992, 63993, 63994, 63995, 63996, 63997, 64001, 64060, 64061, 64062, 64090, 64094 and 64108) are linked to the MINDSville@Napiri cluster with the most recent case (Case 64108) linked to the cluster on 7 June. Case 63924 is a 37 year-old female Singaporean who is a resident at MINDSville@Napiri. She was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 31 May.
- x. 8 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63936, 63969, 64046, 64048, 64049, 64057, 64091 and 64093) are linked to the Atacut Singapore cluster, with the most recent cases (Case 64091) linked to the cluster on 6 June, and Case 64093 linked to the cluster on 7 June. Case 63936 is a 26 year-old male Malaysia national who works as a delivery rider for Pizza Hut (Hougang Green). He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 1 June.
- xi. 6 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63964, 63981, 64010, 64011, 64059 and 64103) are linked to the Case 63964 cluster with the most recent case (Case 64103) linked to the cluster on 7 June. Case 63964 is a 61 year-old female Singaporean who works at NTUC FairPrice (Clementi Avenue 3). She was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 1 June.
- xii. 3 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63931, 64020 and 64077) are linked to the Case 63931 cluster, with the most recent case (Case 64077) linked to the cluster on 5 June. Case 63931 is an 82 year-old male Singaporean who is a retiree. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 1 June.
- xiii. 23 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63534, 63535, 63569, 63603, 63624, 63629, 63668, 63669, 63676, 63682, 63694, 63713, 63717, 63726, 63732, 63791, 63793, 63796, 63834, 63871, 64016, 64056 and 64079) are linked to the McDonald's delivery riders cluster with the most recent case (Case 64079) linked to the cluster on 6 June. Case 63534 is a 27 year-old male Malaysia national who works as a delivery rider for IVIC Logistic Pte Ltd and McDonald's (Bedok Reservoir). He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 20 May.
- xiv. 7 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63721, 63748, 63752, 63933, 64050, 64065 and 64066) are linked to the Tektronix cluster with the most recent cases (Cases 64065 and 64066) linked to the cluster on 5 June. Case 63721 is a 50 year-old male Singaporean who works as an engineer at Tektronix Southeast Asia Pte Ltd. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 24 May.
- xv. 4 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63127, 63147, 63377 and 63379) are linked to the White Sands cluster. Case 63127 is a 43 year-old female Myanmar national who is a foreign domestic worker. She was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 12 May.
- xvi. 7 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63714, 63747, 63794, 63909, 64022, 64052 and 64064) are linked to the Case 63714 cluster with the most recent cases (Case 64052) linked to the cluster on 4 June, and Case 64064 linked to the cluster on 5 June. Case 63714 is a 74 year-old male Singaporean who is a retiree. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 24 May.

Case 63446 is a 28 year-old male Singaporean who works as an engineer at Patec Pte Ltd. He was confirmed to have COVID-19 infection on 18 May.
- xxxii. 6 of the confirmed cases (Cases 63319, 63434, 63435, 63436, 63860 and 63861) are linked to the Case 63319 cluster, with the most recent cases (Cases 63860 and 63861) linked to the cluster on 29 May. Those who had been identified as close contacts of confirmed cases would already have been notified by MOH.

As a precautionary measure, persons who had been at these locations during the specified timings should monitor their health closely for 14 days from their date of visit. They should see a doctor promptly if they develop symptoms of acute respiratory infection (such as cough, sore throat and runny nose), as well as fever and loss of taste or smell, and inform the doctor of their exposure history.

Individuals may access the SafeEntry Location Matching Self-Check service via the TraceTogether App or at <https://wereyouthere.safeentry.gov.sg> to check whether they were at these locations during the specified timings, based on their own SafeEntry records.

There is no need to avoid places where confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been. The National Environment Agency will engage the management of affected premises to provide guidance on cleaning and disinfection.
